



## Campus Access Control

Starting from November 7,

1. Faculty, staff and students of PU are permitted to enter campus directly.
2. Visitors are permitted to enter campus after providing valid ID and completing registration with campus security.
3. Taichung City Bus Route 162, 301 and 368 operate as normal.

## Office of Academic Affairs

Epidemic Prevention Measures starting from November 7, 2022:

1. Teachers and students should wear facial masks throughout the class.
2. Teachers should provide 7-day online courses for students who are confirmed with COVID-19, and those applying for epidemic prevention leave should provide online courses and recordings based on the period stated in the leave slip.
3. If the teacher is confirmed with COVID-19, or has symptoms during the self-initiated prevention period, please take the initiative to provide online courses during this period and inform all enrolled students.
4. During the period of diagnosis, home isolation, home quarantine, self-initiated prevention or epidemic prevention leave, students will not be included in the absence record and their academic performance evaluation will not be affected.

## Office of Student Affairs

Epidemic Prevention Measures starting from November 7, 2022:

1. Adjustment of epidemic prevention guidelines for confirmed cases and close contacts:
  - (1) Confirmed cases receiving home care can be released from self-health management once they test negative on a rapid antigen test after seven days of isolation.
  - (2) If the family members who live with you or the roommates in the same dormitory are confirmed with COVID-19, the close contacts are exempted from home isolation, and 0+7 days of self-initiated prevention measures will be implemented.



## Office of Student Affairs

【During the self-prevention period of close contacts, if they are "symptomatic", they cannot attend school (class) or work; if they are "asymptomatic" and have a negative result from rapid antigen tests within two days, they are allowed to attend school (class) for class or work.】

2. Epidemic prevention measures for student dormitories are adjusted as follows :

- (1) Residential students should wear a mask and use their student ID card for entering and leaving the dormitory. Body temperature measurement policy and APP are cancelled.
- (2) There are thermometers and rubbing alcohol available at the entrances and exits of the dormitory. Residents can use it as needed. If you feel unwell, please report to the dormitory office or service desk.
- (3) Visitors (including relatives and friends) are not permitted to stay.

4. Student leave information:

- (1) Students who are confirmed or have close contacts should report to the E campus service network. Those who are unable to attend physical classes at the school should obtain online courses from their teachers to continue learning; "
- (2) Students do not need to apply for "epidemic prevention leave" after completing the notification for online learning.

<b>Office of Personnel</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Starting from November 7, 2022, teachers and staff will be exempted from home isolation and implementation of 0+7 self-prevention measures due to confirmed cases of their family members or roommates in the same dormitory, regardless of whether the booster vaccine shot is completed or not.</li><li>2. During the self-initiated prevention period, if you have symptoms, you are not required to go to school (class) or go to work; if you are asymptomatic and have a negative result from rapid antigen test within two days, you are allowed to go to school (class) for class and work.</li></ol>
<b>Public Gathering</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Starting from November 7, 2022, the regulations on temperature measurement in public areas will be cancelled.</li><li>2. Teachers and students should wear facial masks throughout the whole process of participating in various activities, meetings, symposiums and seminars, and maintain social distance. If there are dietary needs, masks can be temporarily removed, and masks should be worn immediately afterward.</li></ol>
<b>Library</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Starting from November 7, 2022, you can swipe your card at the entrance of the gate from 1F to the B1 access control.</li><li>2. If documents cannot be returned due to confirmed cases or isolation, please email or call extension 11651 (books)/11679 (DVD), and the borrowing period will be extended by the library.</li></ol>
<b>Office of IT Services</b>	<p>The computer classroom is closed for disinfection from 12:00 to 12:50 every day. Available for the rest of the time period.</p>
<b>Sports Facilities</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Sports facilities are open for use in accordance with epidemic prevention regulations, regular cleaning, prohibition of eating and drinking, and strengthening of hand hygiene.</li></ol>



## Sports Facilities

2. When exercising (including sports courses), you should maintain an appropriate distance, and manage your own health. Only those who have no respiratory symptoms and other related symptoms can participate in sports activities. Masks are not mandatory during sports and competitions, but masks are still required to be worn throughout the rest period; referees may not wear masks during competitions and must still be worn throughout the whole process after rest or after the competition, in accordance with epidemic prevention guidelines.
3. When entering the swimming pool, you should wear a mask throughout the rest of the time except for swimming.

## Continuing Education
