



Pandemic Prevention Announcement in the Beginning of 2022 Fall Semester

Entrance control

1. The faculty, staff, and students may enter the campus after passing the self-temperature measurement and enhanced hand hygiene.
2. Visitors shall have their temperature taken at the Campus Security and register at the contact tracing system before entering the campus.
3. The Routes 162, 301, and 368 of Taichung City Bus will operate as usual.

Office of Academic Affairs

1. Effective August 29, all procedures for suspension or withdrawal of studies will be handled in person; online application service is terminated.
2. All teachers and students are required to wear masks throughout the class, and fixed seat are called in class.
3. Six weeks of online classes will be provided to the students with delayed entry to the country.
4. The 17+1 weeks of innovative teaching will be in place this semester. Please refer to the School Beginning Announcement.
5. Pending on the CDC's epidemic prevention regulations, related rules will be revised on a rolling basis.

Office of Personnel

During the epidemic, the handling principles for work and leave taking for the staff are as follows:

1. In accordance with the MOC's epidemic prevention measures for the new semester at all levels of school, the principles for handling work and leave request for staff have been revised.

1. Student Housing:

(1) **Check-in:** Please submit the Personal Profile Card and Health Declaration upon checking in to the dorms. During the epidemic prevention period, only one family member is allowed to enter the dorm to help with the luggage.

(2) **Epidemic prevention at the dorms:** The access to the dorm complies the epidemic prevention measures. Visitors (including family and friends) are not allowed to stay over night. Non-resident of the dorm are also barred from entering the dorms. The University has planned and scheduled dorms for isolation/quarantine purposes. In the future, when it is necessary, dorms will be requisitioned and allocated for epidemic prevention purposes. Resident students are requested to cooperate with the development.

2. Health Care:

(1) **Health monitor:** Personnel who wear masks throughout the activities with the ones of confirmed cases (and positive cases by quick-screening) need to conduct self-health monitoring. Personnel who join the activities without masks for more than 15 minutes, the Health Center will provide 1 dose of quick screening reagent or self-quick screening. Those who test negative in the quick screening can attend the class as usual; if they have symptoms, they should seek medical treatment as soon as possible and do not attend school.

📞 If students are not well or have doubts about the negative results of the quick test, they can contact the following personnel: During office hours, contact Counseling and Health Center at 04-23628001, ext. 11232. For non-office hours, contact Campus Security Center at 0921-382470 for continuous care and respond.

(2) **Self-monitoring:** The ones who are under home quarantine (or dorm residents staying in the quarantine dorm) should not show up at the campus and should not attend any classes during self-monitoring period.

(3) [COVID-19自主回報疫調系統](#) Confirmed cases: Those of confirmed cases, in addition to reply the CDC report system, should also go to e-Campus>Office of Student Affairs>[COVID-19 Self-Report System](#) to update the campus epidemic condition. After 7-day home quarantine, students who show no signs of symptoms can attend the classes as usual.

(4) **Guidance and Counseling:** If the University adopts online teaching due to epidemic escalation, in-person counseling will be suspended and replaced by communication counseling.

<p>Sports venues</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1.Sports facilities are open under epidemic prevention regulations, with regular cleaning and sanitization. No food or drinks are allowed. Hand hygiene is strengthened. 2.When exercising (including PhyEd courses), all should maintain an appropriate distance and manage your own health. Only those who are confirmed respiratory symptoms or other related symptoms free can participate in sports activities. Masks may not be required during sports and competitions, but masks are still required throughout the rest period. Referees may not wear masks during competitions but must still wear a mask throughout the whole process during the recess or after the competition. All shall follow the epidemic prevention guidelines. 3.At swimming pool, except when swimming, you should wear a mask at all times.
